The American Women's Literary Club (AWLC) was founded in Lima in 1922 by a group of women from the United States who shared an interest in literature, the arts and Peruvian culture. The current membership includes a diverse group of English-speaking women of many nationalities, ages, professions, and interests. Some reside in Peru for a limited time while others are permanent residents. The combination fosters rich cultural and social exchange, lasting friendships and a chance to develop many shared interests.

WHAT WE DO

The yearly cycle of club activities begins with a special luncheon in March and closes with an elegant holiday tea in December. On the first Monday of each month from April through November, at 3:00 p.m. the club's general meetings offer a variety of informative and entertaining programs which are followed by refreshments and conversation. Members also enjoy:

- a lending library with books in English
- interest groups such as book clubs, cooking, art, and quilting
- special events, activities and outings
- opportunities for leadership, organizing and networking

SPECIAL PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES

The AWLC has always been strongly committed to the support of education in Peru. The proceeds from our popular bilingual cook-books and our special fundraising events are used to provide help for young women studying to become teachers, as well as a range of other educational projects. Many members also do volunteer work with local education, health, and development organizations.

The AWLC has been a member of the GFWC, the General Federation of Women's Clubs, since 1924. The object of this group, which was founded in 1890, has been to unite women's clubs and organizations throughout the world for the purpose of sharing common interests in education, fine arts, intercultural understanding and service to the communities in which they live. PLEASE NOTE:


- Yearly dues are paid each March
